Your Committee on License and Consumer Protection, having under consideration an ordinance introduced by Alderman Michelle Harris (which was referred on December 13, 2017), to amend Sections 4-60-022 and 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago to disallow the issuance of additional alcoholic liquor licenses and package goods licenses in portions of South Woodlawn Avenue, begs leave to recommend that Your Honorable Body *Pass* the ordinance which is transmitted herewith.
