Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 200 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend parking meter areas, as follows:

Establishment And Amendment Of Parking Meters:

Ward	Location
25, 27	West Madison Street: West Madison Street (north and south sides) from North/South Ashland Avenue to North/South Racine Avenue -- install parking meters;
31	North Cicero Avenue: North Cicero Avenue (west side) between West School Street and West Belmont Avenue -- install parking meters and also West Diversey Avenue: West Diversey Avenue (north side) between North Lamont Avenue and North Lavergne Avenue -- remove parking meters;
42	East Ontario Street: East Ontario Street (north curb) from North McClurg Court to North Fairbanks Court -- 528 feet -- remove parking meter and install no parking tow-away zone (public benefit);
42	West Lake Street (north side) between North LaSalle Street and North Franklin Street, West Lake Street (north side) between North State Street and North Dearborn Street, East Lake Street (south side) between North Wabash Avenue and North State Street -- install parking meters, and also West Lake Street (north side) between North LaSalle Street and North Wells Street -- repeal no parking -- 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. -- 6:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M. -- Monday through Friday, and also West Lake Street (north side) between North Wells Street and North Wacker Drive -- repeal no parking -- 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. -- Monday through Friday (except holidays);
42	North Canal Street: North Canal Street (east curb) from a point 20 feet of West Lake Street to a point 20 feet north thereof and North Canal Street (east curb) from a point 200 feet north of West Lake Street to a point 60 feet north thereof -- install parking meters;

Ward	Location
42	North Franklin Street: North Franklin Street (west side) between West Washington Street and West Randolph Street -- install parking meters;
42	West Warren Avenue: West Warren Avenue (south side) from a point 10 feet west of North Desplaines Street to a point 120 feet west thereof -- install parking meters;
46	West Wilson Avenue: West Wilson Avenue (south side) from North Magnolia Avenue to North Beacon Street -- install parking meters -- 8:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.;
48	West Norwood Avenue: West Norwood Avenue (north and south sides) from North Broadway to the first alley heading west -- remove parking meters;
48	West Argyle Street, between North Sheridan Road and North Broadway, North Kenmore Avenue, between West Winona Street and West Ainslie Street, and North Winthrop Avenue, between West Winona Street and West Ainslie Street; amendment of Municipal Code Section 9-64-206 regulating parking meters and hours of operation to include 8:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. on Sundays.
