*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through, as follows:

4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance.)

~~(21.129) On Vincennes Avenue, from 81<sup>st</sup> Street to 83<sup>rd</sup> Street; and on 82<sup>nd</sup> Street and on 82<sup>nd</sup> Place, both from Vincennes Avenue to Wallace Street.~~

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the area described in Section 2 of this ordinance is adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (25.217), as follows:

4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance.)

(25.217) On 22<sup>nd</sup> Place, from Wentworth to Princeton and on Wentworth, from Cermak Road to 23<sup>rd</sup> Street.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
