SECTION 1. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through, as follows:

4-60-023 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional packaged goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

~~(43.6) On the north side of West Armitage Avenue, from Halsted Street to Fremont Street.~~

Your Committee on License and Consumer Protection, having under consideration a substitute ordinance introduced by Alderman Ameya Pawar (which was referred on

January 17, 2018), to amend Sections 4-60-022 and 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago regarding alcoholic liquor licenses and package goods licenses in portions of the 47<sup>th</sup> Ward, begs leave to recommend that Your Honorable Body *Pass* the substitute ordinance which is transmitted herewith.

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Sections 2 through 12 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (47.57), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of March 16, 2016 at page 20040, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (47.57) On Southport Avenue, from Byron Street to Berteau Avenue.

SECTION 3. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (47.30), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of September 24, 2015 at page 14021, with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (47.30) On Irving Park Road, from Ravenswood Avenue to Damen Avenue.

SECTION 4. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (47.18), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of May 6, 2015 at page 108491, with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (47.18) On Damen Avenue, from Irving Park Road to Berteau Avenue.

SECTION 5. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (47.46), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago*, of September 10, 2014 at page 87961, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (47.46) On Montrose Avenue, from Ravenswood Avenue to Damen Avenue.

SECTION 6. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (47.35), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of April 2, 2014 at page 77633, with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (47.35) On Lawrence Avenue, from Ravenswood Avenue to Damen Avenue.

SECTION 7. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (47.34), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of April 2, 2014, with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (47.34) On Lawrence Avenue, from Ashland Avenue to Ravenswood Avenue.

SECTION 8. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (47.2), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of January 15, 2015, with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (47.2) On Addison Street, from Damen Avenue to Leavitt Street.

SECTION 9. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (47.70), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of September 10, 2014 at page 87961, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (47.70) On Wilson Avenue, from Ravenswood Avenue to Damen Avenue.

SECTION 10. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (47.35), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of July 24, 2013 at page 58054, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (47.35) On Lawrence Avenue, from Ravenswood Avenue to Damen Avenue.

SECTION 11. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-022 (47.12), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of January 17, 2013 at page 45330, with the following underscored text:

4-60-022 (47.12) On Clark Street, from Byron Street to Berteau Avenue.

SECTION 12. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by replacing subsection 4-60-023 (47.30), which was previously deleted as shown in the *Journal of the Proceedings of the City Council of the City of Chicago* of January 17, 2013 at page 45343, with the following underscored text:

4-60-023 (47.30) On Irving Park Road, from Ravenswood Avenue to Damen Avenue.

SECTION 13. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
