SECTION 1. That the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by designating with the appropriate symbols and indications that segment of the North Lincoln Avenue right-of-way on Map Number 5-F in the area bounded by:

the centerline of West Belden Avenue on the north and the centerline of West Webster Avenue on the south,

as a Pedestrian Retail Street.

SECTION 2. That Section 17-3-0503-D of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance be amended by inserting the underscored language as follows:

17-3-0503-D [Pedestrian Streets And Pedestrian Retail Streets.]
