

ORDINANCE NO. 10508 (N.S.)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 43.101, 43.102 AND 43.103 OF CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 3, TITLE 4 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES; CHANGING THE TITLE OF DIVISION 3 OF TITLE 4 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES; AND REPEALING SECTION 33.109 OF CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 3, TITLE 3 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The title of Division 3 of Title 4 of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances, and sections 43.101, 43.102 and 43.103 of Chapter 1 of Division 3, Title 4, are amended to read as follows:

DIVISION 3. COUNTY FACILITIES AND PROPERTY

CHAPTER 1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

SEC. 43.101. CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR COUNTY FACILITIES AND PROPERTY

(a) The Chief Administrative Officer shall adopt and implement rules and regulations regarding the operation, use of and access to County facilities and property. The rules and regulations shall be available at County facilities during normal business hours, shall be available on the County internet website, and posted conspicuously on County property where such rules and regulations apply.

SEC. 43.102. COMPLIANCE WITH RULES, REGULATIONS, SIGNS AND ORDERS

(a) No person shall refuse or fail to comply with any rule or regulation adopted by the Chief Administrative Officer pursuant to this Chapter.

(b) No person shall disregard, deface, alter or tamper with any warning or instructional sign located in a County facility or on County property.

(c) Any law enforcement officer, or other person designated by the Chief Administrative Officer, may order a person to leave a County facility or property if the person violates subsection (a) or (b) above or if the person violates any other provision of this chapter.

(d) It shall be unlawful for any person to refuse to leave a County facility or property after being ordered to leave pursuant to subsection (c) above. A person may not refuse to leave a County facility or property on the grounds that the person believes the order to leave is unjustified.

SEC. 43.103 . VIOLATIONS.

(a) Any violation of this Chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor except where charged as an infraction pursuant to section 11.116 of this code.

(b) In addition to initiating a criminal prosecution under paragraph (a) above, the County may also recover civil penalties of up to \$2,500 a day against a person for each day the person violates a provision of this Chapter.

Section 2. Section 33.109 of Chapter 1, Division 3, Title 3 of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage, and before the expiration of fifteen days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
