ORDINANCE NO. 10653 (NEW SERIES)

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE
RELATED TO WINERIES TO ALLOW FOR TEMPORARY AGRITOURISM
COMMUNITY EVENTS (POD 19-002)**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the Zoning Ordinance should be updated by amending or adding sections regarding Temporary Agritourism Community Events. The Board finds that these amendments are reasonable and necessary for the public health, safety, convenience, and welfare.

Section 2. Section 6910 Wholesale Limited, Boutique and Small Wineries of the Zoning Ordinance is amended to read as follows:

The provisions of Section 6910 shall be known as the Wholesale Limited, Boutique and Small Wineries Regulations. The purpose of these regulations is to promote production of wine from fruit grown in San Diego County, to support local agriculture and to prescribe reasonable standards and procedures for the operation of wineries. Commercial activities not expressly allowed pursuant to the provisions of Section 6910 are prohibited, with the exception of Temporary Agritourism Community Events as defined in Section 6157.b.4.
