

ORDINANCE NO. 9316 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, WEIGHTS AND MEASURES, ADDING A FEE SCHEDULE FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY VETERINARIAN AND INCREASING THE FEES

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that the fees charged for services provided by the County Veterinarian have not been increased since 1981, but the costs to provide these services have increased. The Board further finds and determines that it is necessary and in the public interest to increase the County Veterinarian's fees to recover a greater portion of the County's costs to provide these veterinarian services.

Section 2. Section 176.10 is added to Article XII-B of the San Diego County Administrative Code to read as follows:

FEES FOR COUNTY VETERINARIAN SERVICES

The following fees shall be paid to the County Veterinarian for the following services:

SEROLOGY/NEWCASTLE	15.00
PUBLIC HEALTH TESTS	20.00
OTHER TESTS, AGRICULTURE	20.00
OTHER TESTS, NONAGRICULTURE	25.00
ADDITIONAL LAB FEE	20.00
RABIES TEST	0.00

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in the San Diego Daily Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation in the County of San Diego.
