

ORDINANCE NO.10468 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 72.169.92.1. AND 72.169.92.2.AND ADDING SECTIONS 72.169.92.1.1. AND 72.169.92.2.1. TO THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY CODE RELATING TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 72.169.92.1. of the San Diego County Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.169.92.1. ALPINE. The prima facie speed limit on South Grade Road from the south line of Arnold Way easterly to the north line of Rocrest Road is hereby decreased to and established at 45 miles per hour.

Section 72.169.92.2. of the San Diego County Code is amended to read as follows:

Section 72.169.92.2. ALPINE. The prima facie speed on South Grade Road from the east line of Tavern Road easterly to the south line of Via Viejas is hereby decreased to and established at 45 miles per hour.

Section 72.169.92.1.1. of the San Diego County Code is added to read as follows:

Section 72.169.92.1.1. ALPINE. The prima facie speed limit on South Grade Road from the south line of Rocrest Road southerly to the west line of Tavern Road is hereby decreased to and established at 40 miles per hour.

Section 72.169.92.2.1. of the San Diego County Code is added to read as follows:

Section 72.169.92.2.1. ALPINE. The prima facie speed limit on South Grade Road from the north line of Via Viejas easterly to the south line of Alpine Boulevard is hereby decreased to and established at 40 miles per hour.
