

ORDINANCE NO. 9069 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 444 OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO RESERVE OFFICERS? REIMBURSEMENT FOR UNIFORMS, EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING AND ACQUISITION OF UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT FOR VOLUNTEER PATROL MEMBERS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 444 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 444. RESERVE OFFICERS? REIMBURSEMENT FOR UNIFORMS, EQUIPMENT AND CLOTHING AND ACQUISITION OF UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT FOR VOLUNTEER PATROL MEMBERS.

The Sheriff is hereby authorized to reimburse a Reserve Deputy for uniform and equipment expenses up to \$250 per calendar year. In addition, whenever a Reserve Deputy or Sheriff?s Explorer Scout is directed by the Sheriff to perform voluntary service during a law enforcement or rescue mission and while so serving suffers damage to articles of clothing or equipment necessarily worn or carried on said mission, he may be reimbursed for such loss under the limitations and procedure prescribed in Section 79.1 of this code.

The Sheriff is hereby authorized to purchase the necessary uniforms and equipment for department volunteers. Volunteer patrol members perform a voluntary service to ensure the safety of the public and require uniforms and equipment to carry out their duties.
