

ORDINANCE NO. 9881 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PORTIONS OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY  
CODE OF REGULATORY ORDINANCES RELATING TO THE POSTING OF  
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL WARNING SIGNS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. This ordinance change eliminates duplicative requirements found in state law that are enforced by the State Alcoholic Beverage Control program.

Section 2. Sections 61.401 through 61.405 of the San Diego County Code related to the posting of warning signs at all locations where alcoholic beverages are sold to the public, are hereby deleted.
