

ORDINANCE NO. 9951 (N.S.)

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLES XII-E AND LIV
OF THE SAN DIEGO COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE
CODE RELATING TO THE PESTICIDE TASK
FORCE AND SAN DIEGO SOLID WASTE HEARING
PANEL AND REPEALING ARTICLES XXXI AND XXXV
OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING
TO PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT AND ASSESSEMENT
PROCEEDINGS AND THE NOISE CONTROL HEARING BOARD**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors finds and determines that various provisions in the County Administrative Code relating to the Pesticide Task Force and Solid Waste Hearing Board should be amended to make these ordinances consistent with state law and County practice. The Board also finds that the provisions in the Administrative Code relating to the Public Improvement and Assessment Proceedings and the Noise Control Hearing Board are obsolete or no longer needed and should be repealed.

Section 2. Section 204.1 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 204.1. MEMBERSHIP AND SELECTION.

To the extent feasible, the Integrated Pest Management Committee shall represent a cross section of organizations and groups involved in pesticide management as follows:

1. through 9. [No change.]
10. Ad hoc members from appropriate County departments as determined by the Agricultural Commissioner.

Section 3. Section 204.2 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 204.2. APPOINTMENTS.

Persons shall be nominated by the Board Chair and appointed by the Board of Supervisors to fill the first nine positions. The ad hoc members shall be appointed by the Agricultural Commissioner.

Section 4. Section 204.2 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 204.3. TERM OF OFFICE.

Members appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall serve a term of office for two years, or until the committee is dissolved by Board action, whichever occurs first. Members appointed by the Agricultural Commissioner shall serve when needed as determined by the Agricultural Commissioner.

Section 5. Section 204.7 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 204.7. COMPENSATION.

Members of the Integrated Pest Management Committee appointed by the Board of Supervisors shall serve without compensation, provided, however, that the members shall be entitled to mileage reimbursement in accordance with applicable County ordinances.

Section 6. Section 860.2 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 860.2. TERM OF OFFICE.

Members shall serve a term of office for four years. The initial terms of the members shall be staggered, with the public member term expiring in 1994. Any member whose term has expired hereunder shall continue to discharge the duties as a member until a successor has been appointed and qualified. Members of the Panel shall not serve more than two consecutive terms.

Section 7. Section 860.5 of the San Diego County Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

SEC. 860.5. ORGANIZATION.

(a) through (d) [No change.]

(e) The Panel shall meet as often as may be necessary for the transaction of business and shall give public notice of the time and place of meetings at least 30 days in advance of all meetings and this notice shall be in compliance with the requirements of the Brown Act. All meetings of the Panel shall be open and public and all persons shall be permitted to attend any meetings of the Panel.

(f) [No change.]

Section 8. Article XXXI of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 9. Article XXXV of the San Diego County Administrative Code is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, a summary hereof shall be published once with the names of the members of this Board voting for and against it in the San Diego Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
