

ORDINANCE NO 9991 (NEW SERIES)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPENSATION ORDINANCE
AND ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION IMPLEMENTING A
NEGOTIATED TWO YEAR EXTENSION OF THE
MEMORANDA OF AGREEMENT WITH THE
DEPUTY SHERIFFS' ASSOCIATION OF SAN DIEGO COUNTY

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego ordains as follows:

Section 1. Appendix One of the Compensation Ordinance is hereby amended by establishing compensation for classes designated DS and SM effective June 18, 2010.

Section 2. Subsection (d) (5) of Section 5.1.6 of the Compensation Ordinance is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5.1.6: FLEXIBLE BENEFITS PLAN:

(d) County Contributions Toward Flexible Benefit Plan. Insurance premium costs shall be borne by the employee excepting that the County shall make the following contribution toward the Flexible Benefits Plan (which includes health insurance). The employee's insurance premium costs will be reduced by the amount the employee elects to distribute to his or her insurance premium costs from the County's contribution toward the Flexible Benefits Plan. The County's contribution toward the Flexible Benefits Plan shall be:

(5) Employees in classes designated DS and SM under the SHRF Benefit Program.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance affects compensation and shall take effect upon adoption. Within fifteen days after the date of adoption of this ordinance, a summary shall be published once with the name of those members voting for and against the same in the newspaper of general circulation published in the County of San Diego.
